Art Escapes invites you to join our Executive Director Nannette Maciejunes to experience *Georgia O'Keeffe: Living Modern* at the Cleveland Museum of Art. The exhibition offers a unique look into the fascinating connections between the paintings, personal style, and public persona of one of America's most iconic artists. Her distinctively modern style of clothing is exhibited beside many of her paintings. Cleveland's Curator of American Painting and Sculpture Mark Cole, a great friend of the Columbus Museum of Art, will provide an introduction to the exhibition and will be available to answer questions in the gallery.

After lunch in the Museum Café, we will visit another modern exhibition *Charles Burchfield: The Ohio Landscapes, 1915–1920*. Nannette, who before becoming the Museum Director, was the Burchfield scholar of record, will join us in the gallery to discuss the show. The exhibition presents about 30 works on paper made between 1915 and 1920, the period surrounding what Burchfield described as his “golden year.”

The cost is \$145 for CMA members and \$155 for nonmembers. Included is a private coach, light breakfast, admission and private introduction to featured exhibitions, free time to explore the museum, lunch voucher for the Cleveland Museum of Art Café, and light snacks for the return trip.
