Social Story

Prepare for your visit through a visual Social Story about experiencing the Museum. A paper copy of this Social Story is available at the Admissions Desk. You can review the CMA Social Story on any chairs in the Atrium.

Personal Items

You can use personal items to make your visit more enjoyable. Other visitors may also have these items in the galleries:

- Earphones
- Technology
- Stuffed animals and fidget objects
- Photography devices (without flash, tripods, or selfie sticks)
- Pencil and paper (pencil sketching may occur in the galleries)
- Wheelchairs, strollers, and other mobility items

Tip: There are a few wheelchairs and strollers available for use at no charge at the Admissions Desk.

Food & Drink

You may bring your own food and drink into CMA and enjoy it in:

- the Atrium
- the Sculpture Garden
- Derby Court

You also may purchase food at or dine in the Schokko Art Café, located on the right when entering the Museum. The Café offers:

- Soups, appetizers, salads, sandwiches, entrees, side dishes, and desserts
- Packaged grab-n-go items
- Child-friendly options
- Vegetarian options

Tip: The Schokko Art Café is busiest from noon – 2:00 pm.



Bathrooms

- CMA has 2 individual, fully accessible restrooms on the first floor.
- There are restrooms with stalls near the Schokko Art Café
- A Comfort Room is located on the first floor in the Center for Creativity. It includes 2 comfy chairs, a sink, and a diaper changing station. Everyone is welcome to use this space.
- All CMA restrooms include hand dryers and paper towels.

Tip: The sinks in restrooms located in the New Wing feature hand dryers attached to the faucet-watch out for a quick burst of air.

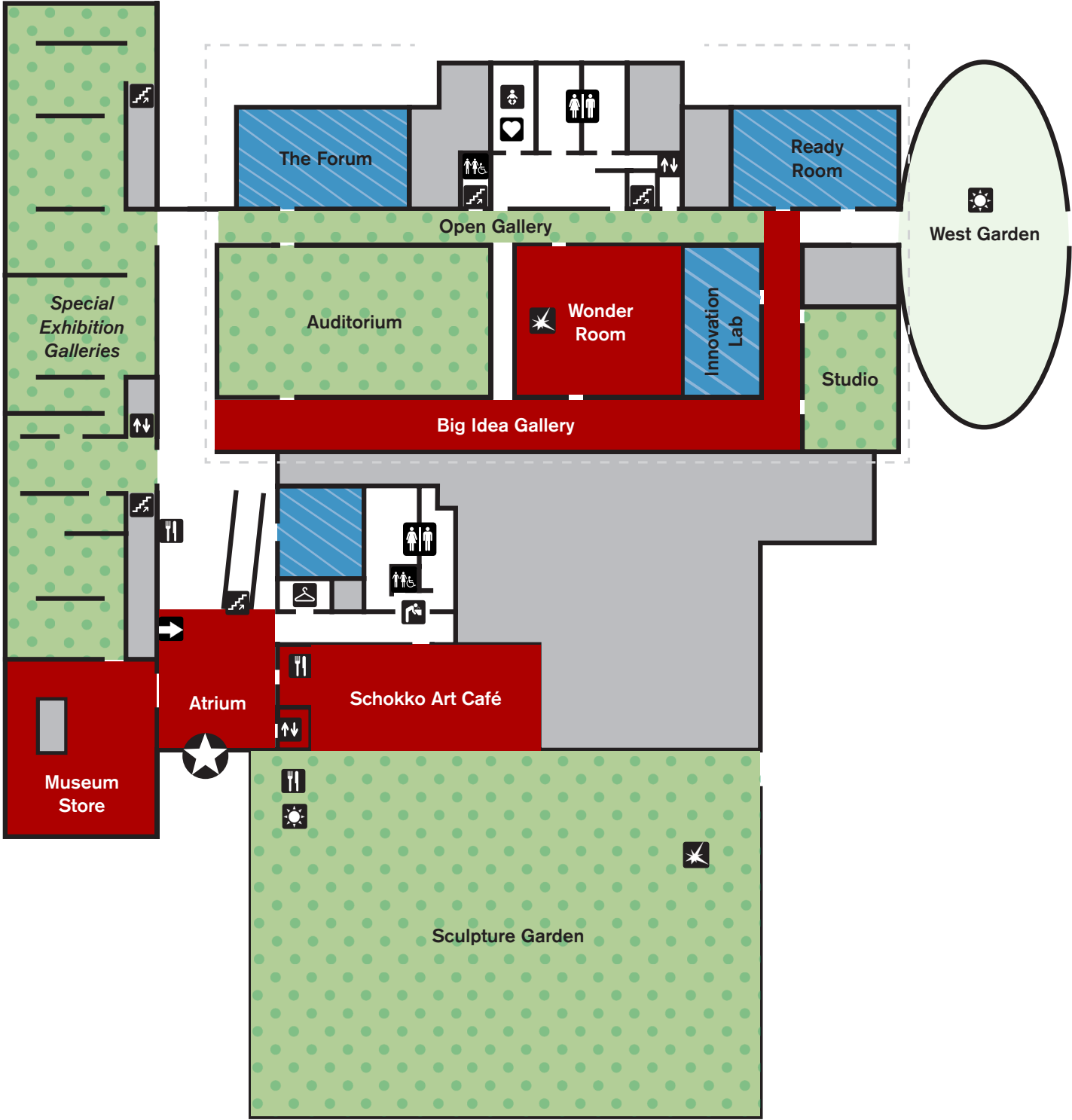
